- ✓ Do **NOT** place recyclables in non-recyclable plastic bags. Use a tub or basket to transport recyclables from your kitchen to your recycling bin to ensure your recycling efforts are not wasted.
- ✓ It is **NOT** necessary to peel labels off containers as they are taken out during the recycling process
- ✓ Cardboard, paper, newspapers, and magazines do not need to be bundled. Just insure that they will not blow around when placed at the curb.
- ✓ Batteries and ink jet cartridges are to be brought to Borough Hall or placed in a separate curbside container from other recyclables.
- ✓ Please remove the lids on bottles and jars so they can be easily compacted in the truck.
- ✓ **ALL** Recyclables may be mixed together or **CO MINGLED**.
