It's New Jersey law to recycle. What can you recycle?

WHAT	WHEN
Aluminum & B-Metal Cans (all empty steel cans, aluminum soft drink cans, empty aerosol cans)	Recycling Days – See Directory (Do not put in plastic bags) Use tub or basket to transport recyclables from your kitchen to your recycling bin to ensure your recycling efforts are not wasted.
Glass Bottles and Jars (clear & colored) Lids must be removed – no need to peel off labels	Recycling Days – See Directory (Do not put in plastic bags) Use tub or basket to transport recyclables from your kitchen to your recycling bin to ensure your recycling efforts are not wasted.
Cardboard & brown paper bags	Recycling Days – See Directory (Do not put in plastic bags) (No waxed containers Ex: Milk/Juice ½ gallon containers, juice boxes) Need to be bundled and placed at curb so they don't blow away or fall apart when picked up.
Newspapers, Magazines, Junk Mail, Office Paper	Recycling Days – See Directory (Do not put in plastic bags) Need to be bundled and placed at curb so they don't blow away or fall apart when picked up.
Plastic Bottles (#1-7)	Recycling Days- See Directory (milk bottles, liquor bottles, detergent bottles, plastic containers) (Do not put in plastic bags) Use tub or basket to transport recyclables from your kitchen to your recycling bin to ensure your recycling efforts are not wasted.

Laser/Ink Jet Cartridges	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bring to Borough Hall or place in a separate curbside container from other recyclables. • Hampton Elementary School • Also Staples and Office Depot
Leaves	Must be put in paper bags. See directory for dates of pickup.
Scrap Metals	Place at Curb With Garbage and Correct Number of "Extra Trash" stickers
Textiles (clothing & Fabric)	Donation boxes at Glen Gardner Fire Department, A&P and Glen Gardner Youth

White Goods (Large Appliances)	All appliances containing FREON must have certification that the FREON HAS BEEN REMOVED or a FREON REMOVAL STICKER must be purchased from the Municipal Office before pick-up will occur. Purchase sticker \$25.00 at Clerk's office ("Extra Trash" stickers also required).
Car Batteries	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hunterdon County Division of Solid Waste & Recycling www.co.hunterdon.nj.us/recycling.html• Padik Auto Parts, 423 Route 513, Califon, NJ (Batteries go on rack in front of the store 24/7)
AA, AAA, B,C,D & 9V Batteries	Regular Garbage as of February 2011 (Since 1997 these batteries had the mercury content reduced by 90% & are now considered safe in the landfill)
Rechargeable Batteries	Radio Shack, Best Buy, Staples
Car Tires (Off Rims) and Truck Tires (Off Rims)	Place at Curb With Garbage with currently 4 trash stickers per tire

We **do not** accept the following:

CEMENT, PAINT, MOTOR OIL, ANTI-FREEZE, GRASS CLIPPINGS, CAR BATTERIES, OR OTHER HAZARDOUS MATERIALS.

ALL Recyclables may be mixed together or CO-MINGLED.

SANITATION POLICY

The Borough of Glen Gardner Sanitation Department collects garbage every Monday **except holidays**. If Monday is a holiday pick-up will be on Tuesday. Garbage will be collected the next scheduled workday following a holiday. We will pick up two cans (35 GALLON LIMIT) or four bags. Stickers are required to dispose of extra bags or materials not part of standard trash pick-up. Below is a general list of items most commonly disposed of and the amount of stickers needed. Please call the Public Works Department for items not on the list.

5 x 7 or 6 x 9	2
8 x 11 and up	3
** Any rug cut into smaller bundles needs 1 sticker per bundle**

Car tires (off rims)	4 each
Truck tires (off rims)	4 each
Entry or Screen Doors	2 each
Windows	2 each
Weight Benches/Exercise Equipment	3
Construction Debris (must be bundled no more than 50 pounds)	1 each
Grills	3
Microwave Ovens	2

**** APPLIANCE NOTE **** All appliances containing FREON must have certification that the FREON HAS BEEN REMOVED or a FREON REMOVAL STICKER must be purchased from the Municipal Office before pickup will occur. Purchase sticker \$25.00 at Clerk's office (regular stickers also required.)

We do not accept the following: CEMENT, PAINT, MOTOR OIL, ANTI-FREEZE, GRASS CLIPPINGS, CAR BATTERIES, COMMERCIAL TRUCK TIRES, OR OTHER HAZARDOUS MATERIALS.

Hazardous Materials can be brought to the quarterly Hunterdon County Hazardous Waste Cleanup Days. For more information contact by phone (908) 788-1110 or by e-mail hcua@co.hunterdon.nj.us.

Three yard dumpsters are available to rent for homeowner's use for \$100.00. Call the Public Works Department for availability and scheduling, 537-4510. Fee paid at Borough Clerk's office.

The following items will not be picked up anymore with your trash:

COMPUTERS, MONITORS, SPEAKERS, TV'S VCR'S, DVD AND CD PLAYERS, FAX MACHINES, STEREO EQUIPMENT, RADIO'S, CELL PHONES & CORDLESS TELEPHONES. These items will have to be brought down to the Public Works Garage and will be accepted free of charge on separate collection days in the year. The collection days will be announced on the Borough Website www.glengardnernj.org. In January of 2011 NJ Law required all electronics to be recycled.
